Winsor or Thalo Green (Green Shade)  
Winsor or Thalo Blue (Green Shade)  
Viridian

##### **Blues:**

Cobalt Blue  
Ultramarine blue  
Indanthene Blue

##### **Yellows:**

Quinachridone Gold  
Aureolin, Lemon, or Transparent Yellow  
New Gamboge or Hansa Yellow Deep (DS)

##### **Reds:**

Permanent Rose  
Winsor or Perylene Red (DS)

##### **Earth Hues:**

Brown Madder  
Burnt Sienna  
Quinachridone Sienna

#### **Supplies:**

1 full sheet of Arches 140 lb or Lanaquarelle cold press paper quartered into 11" X 15" sheets  
1 Sheet of Transfer Paper  
1" Flat watercolor brush  
# 10-12 round watercolor brush  
# 6-8 round brush

Masking tape, pencil, hair dryer, 2 pint size plastic water containers, 11" X 15" waterproof support, covered plastic palette.
